## Peaceful Existence of Militaries

This policy position pertains to the peaceful existence of militaries, or militaries around the world that agree not to conflict.

Militaries shall not conflict at all, even when there is a verbal or intellectual conflict, as verbal statements and intellectual differences of opinion that are damaging in nature need not be verified to be false, if they are not physically apparent in Measurements and Signatures Intelligence (MASINT) or Global Security Intelligence (GSINT) from global security satellite surveillance capabilities.

War shall not even occur as a last resort. The success of wealthy nations has always been to not enter military conflict, and to instead focus on world trade, or the betterment of its own people through commerce. Offensive military acts that are not in the nature of only dismantling only the weapons systems that pose an immediate actionable threat to the domestic sovereignty of a nation, shall never occur. War shall never be conducted to dismantle weapons systems in a foreign nation, even due to movements of the weapons within the territorial sovereignty of that same nation, even when there are verbal or intellectual conflicts.

Weapons systems will not "build-up" when there are not other weapons races, therefore weapons races are illegal, as well, and shall never occur. Treasonous military acts, such as genocide and nuclear war, shall never occur.
